The space has been converted into a large open plan living area featuring a spectacular blackbutt floating floor. A beautiful timber solar pergola provides weather protection for the front door, and a dark and uninspiring living space has been transformed into a home that glistens with natural light.

The incredible transformation of a small weatherboard cottage in O'Connor has delighted its owners. Refurbishing the existing timber clad residence and adding a rear extension created a wonderful home with a new kitchen and living areas. The rear extension is the crowning glory of this project. Constructed of reverse brick veneer on a formed concrete plinth, the imposing structure is supported by steel portal frames holding a partly suspended mezzanine level. The extension roof is a major feature with its cathedral ceiling pitched at forty five degrees and towering over the hand-crafted interior, featuring recycled timber and painted patterned brickwork.









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



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

Crafted with a split level open plan living area, 3.5m ceilings and feature highlight windows, this home was built to a price for a family developing their first property. With an abundance of natural light, this four-bedroom home offers maximum style and comfort whilst remaining absolutely affordable. Beautifully showcasing the ability for a home to be luxurious and practical, yet wonderfully inexpensive. MSL Projects was able to include all of the features deemed necessary for a great family home. The insightful design includes two large living areas, a quality kitchen with 90cm stainless steel appliances, stone bench tops, walk-in pantry, easy flow indoor and outdoor living, and very importantly ample storage.



With demand for affordable rental housing for lower income earners far outstripping supply in the Canberra region, CHC is planning to activate positive change in collaboration with like-minded partners.

A recent Productivity Commission report revealed close to half of lower income households living in private rental homes in the ACT spend more than 30 per cent of household income on rent.

Canberra is the second least affordable area behind Greater Sydney for lower income earners, according to Anglicare's Rental Affordability Index (May 2018). Housing stress is intensified by the high cost of rent in Canberra's private market. At CHC, we have sharpened our focus – a focus which will help address this challenging situation for many.

As the largest not-for-profit community housing provider in the ACT, we're actively pursuing partnership opportunities - with Government, landholders, debt and equity capital market participants, developers, and support providers – to accelerate delivery against our target to deliver affordable rental homes for over 2000 Canberrans by 2022.

Part of this includes better leveraging fee-for-service and head lease arrangements with third-party owned homes, whether developed by CHC or not, as an avenue to grow supply.

By growing the supply of affordable rental homes for lower income earners, CHC aims to help fill the affordability gap that exists between government-provided public housing (Housing ACT) and the private rental market, while also stimulating development activity in the region.

This sharper focus aligns with our mission to provide affordable homes, predominantly for rent, and builds on our vision of creating safe and secure homes in strong communities.

We believe a home is much more than bricks and mortar. For many CHC tenants, our housing has opened doors to employment and study, and improved health and wellbeing.

Currently, CHC provides affordable rental homes for more than 1300 Canberrans, via 447 tenancies. Most of these homes have been developed by CHC.

Our portfolio includes a range of standard one-, two-, threeand four-bedroom houses, townhouses and apartments, and specialist properties, such as group homes and accommodation for people with disability.

Over the past 10 years, CHC has worked closely with the ACT Government and other investment partners to deliver new initiatives and close to 1000 homes.

Award-wining joint-venture projects include City Edge, O'Connor (CIC Australia and CHC) and the precinct of Crace (ACT Government, CIC Australia, DHA, CHC and Tatebrook Pty Ltd).

CHC is a credible investment partner with a proven track record, proven joint venture experience, a strong balance sheet with net assets of over \$125m, and a sharpened focus on growing the supply of affordable rental homes for lower income earners in the ACT.



Our current developments, with a direct affordability focus, include:

Group homes, Kambah

Construction has been completed on two, fourbedroom homes, and a five-bedroom specialist group home, all being retained by CHC for affordable rental accommodation.

Specialist homes for people with disability, Kambah

Awaiting DA approval for proposed six, two-bedroom homes, all to be retained by CHC for rental accommodation.

Homes for affordable purchase, Moncrieff and Throsby

Forty-five, two- and three-bedroom homes are close to completion, with several still available as affordable home purchase opportunities, leveraging the ACT Government's Land Rent Scheme.

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



The design of this dual occupancy was cleverly optimised to meet the needs of professionals or retired couples, with each dwelling featuring contemporary elements imparting a warm and homely atmosphere. The features are endless, and include solid timber flooring, fully fitted bespoke joinery, 2.7m high ceilings and natural lighting by way of skylights. 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
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

And despite often working around incredibly tight and detailed junctions, Monarch successfully achieved a clean and refined finish. The set out and execution of the perforated ceiling panels over the large void, were also finished to an exceptional standard.

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
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SUSTAINABLE CONSTRUCTION - RESIDENTIAL

The challenge on this project was to convert an introverted, energy-guzzling, 1960's house into a modern, energy-efficient family home with strong connections to outdoor spaces and social areas. Working with fundamentally 'good bones' from both a design and thermal perspective, and enough floor area, selective internal alterations improved energy efficiency, spatial relationships, circulation and connection to the outdoors, while only adding just 1m² to the building's footprint. The optimisation of thermal performance saw the energy efficiency rating of the house increased from 2.8 stars to 7.7 stars, delivering a 75% reduction in heating and cooling loads across a year in Canberra's climate of extremes.











As you can see, whether it makes more sense to move or to extend depends on a number of different factors. It is not a decision that you will want to make again soon. While it is difficult to gaze into a crystal ball, it might be wise to future-proof your decision as much as possible.

If you are in an established suburb, is the block large enough to cater for future needs. What about planning approval? It can be easier to get planning approval for alterations to an existing building than to get permission for a new house, although that is not always the case.

One final tip should you decide to stay and renovate, is to avoid sacrificing more than you are gaining. For example, if you intend using an existing room to access an extension make sure it is sufficiently large enough to retain its usability. It doesn't make sense to carve up an existing bedroom just to access a new bedroom in the extension.




