A small but clever renovation featuring skylights changed everything! White gyprock covered the dark bricks and timberwork, a new sunroom and deck were complemented by a large sliding door opening the house to the stunning, well-established garden. The five Velux skylights were a mixture of fixed and solar blinds to shut out harsh summer sun when needed, while others had strip LED lighting all positioned to resemble a glass ceiling. This simple, clever conversion providing a surprising 'WoW' factor..

The Public Housing Renewal Taskforce engaged Monarch Building Solutions to construct a multi-level, 'Livable Home' development. The precise brief included easy entry to each dwelling and accessibility inside. It was also seen as important to easily and cost effectively adapt the design for the changing needs of the occupants. The development consists of 22 two-bedroom Livable Gold Level units, and three two-bedroom Livable Class C adaptable townhouses, along with carports and associated landscaping and civil works. Materials and architectural features were carefully considered. While the fascia of the development seems modest, the intricate level of detail required impeccable workmanship. The resounding success of this build was clearly evident to the judging panel.

MULTILEVEL

Mercer Apartments, Kingston

Capturing the classic charm of old Kingston, the generously proportioned Mercer Apartments successfully marry art deco styling with modern living. This impressive building is complemented by a striking cantilevered curved masonry wall, which sets the tone for what lies within. The choice of materials reflects the hand-finished quality of the building. Roman bricks with exquisite corbel detailing around the balconies and parapet are offset by a sweeping expanse of dramatic copper cladding. The grid of expansive windows topped with unique steel awnings completes the façade. This charismatic building sits elegantly in one of Canberra's oldest and most loved suburbs.



CREATED BY AWARD WINNING MBA MEMBERS FOR AWARD WINNING MBA MEMBERS



This year Master Builders invited an award-winning member to design and construct the 2019 Master Builders and Asset Construction Hire Building Excellence Awards Trophy.

Creatively integrating two of the most dominant building materials of glass and wood, the trophy's design is a respectful nod to Master Builders and the broader ACT construction industry.

The trophy designer David Braithwaite of Braithwaite Innovative Joinery says the glass represents the vision each winner has displayed, while timber with its endless variety and characteristics, expresses the unique skills on which the winners have built their project.

Timber has been used as a building material for thousands of years and is the perfect example of an environmentally sustainable product. Carrying the lowest carbon footprint of any comparable building material, timber has never been more popular, so it made perfect sense to design the trophy around timber.

Matt Ryan from Toscan Glass, another award winning MBA member was invited to contribute to the trophy and donated the glass feature, which incorporates the MBA's corporate colours. The combined result is striking.









MEDIUM DENSITY HOUSING - TOWNHOUSES AND VILLAS

BELLEVUE BUILDING PROJECTS AND DNA ARCHITECTS

Haig Townhouses, Turner

This impressive townhouse complex is centrally located in Turner, overlooking the heritage listed Haig Park. The developer's flexible approach was innovative, with all eight residences treated almost as individually designed custom homes. The well resolved base plan and luxury streetscape allowed for significant interior and exterior customisation by the future owners. Kitchens, bathrooms, joinery, fireplaces, light wells, finishes and fixtures all received the personal touch without any loss of quality. Some residents even reused Canberra red bricks from the original building. The landscaped common area provides a real sense of space as well as providing rear access to each private courtyard, five with plunge pools. Basement garaging allows maximum connection with the ground floor amenities and Haig Park.



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
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BEST USE OF MATERIAL - RESIDENTIAL

INDEPENDENT CONSTRUCTIONS

Deakin

The exquisite polished concrete floor finish in this Deakin home was achieved by methodically polishing it several times prior to the final step; an off-white cement and 'Cowra Quartz' stone completed the unique appearance. The outstanding result is testament to the exploitation of the material during construction.

The decorative, polished concrete floor was placed at a slump of 80-90mm, with hydration maintained for 14 days. Two layers of SL81 were used as slab fabric, to minimise any chance of cracking. The pre-cast lid over the entry was set with a drip lip and fall, allowing water to run away from the house. The result is spectacular.














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


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LANDSCAPE DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION - RESIDENTIAL

Mawson

The philosophy that influenced the mesmerising redesign of this house and garden in Mawson, was to plan interior and exterior spaces in perfect harmony. The private garden sanctuary effortlessly connects indoor and outdoor spaces with a continuous flow of 'liveable' luxury. An inspired Japanese dry landscape garden with a 12 metre Koi pond, a ball court, swimming pool and pool house exquisitely balance the 100 plus square metres of lawn and several other individual gardens including the edible variety. While the striking features are awe inspiring, by limiting the design palette to concrete, timber and steel, Brother Projects deliberately achieved refined simplicity in keeping with Japanese styling. Brother Projects interpretation of the desired result was beyond faultless.





The brief for Turner Living Pods was complex. Fulfilling the need for accommodation that would suit young couples, families and the elderly alike, this development has succeeded in creating ultimate flexibility. With young people unable to afford their first home and the older generation facing loneliness, intergenerational living is becoming more popular for many reasons, not least economics. This house combines ground breaking 10 star passive technology with beautiful and functional design, inspired by Japanese geometry and the Australian landscape. With hand finished brickwork, precise detailing and exacting workmanship, the quality throughout is evident. The considered landscaping naturally captures water and has been crafted to mature into a sanctuary over time.

Extensive 3D modelling ensured best use of available space and the custom-made spotted gum handles added the finishing touch.

This Yarralumla kitchen is of the highest quality with meticulous attention to detail. The joinery finished flush with detailed shadow lines, and solid American oak timber island legs added interest. A mix of 2pac poly, stone benchtops and splash backs were used. Likewood, a beautiful alternative to veneers was chosen to add warmth to the finish. Designed for a young family, integrating the kitchen, dining and study areas was important to create a social hub to meet the lifestyle needs of all the family.



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
KITCHEN PROJECT \$50,000 TO \$80,000

Very importantly, particularly with such a bold colour palette, fingerprints belong in the past. Nanotechnology has delivered an ingenious product – Nover Fenix NTM Matt Laminate an attractive hardwearing, easy care, anti-fingerprint surface. Add to this Blackbutt timber, Qasair concealed rangehood, Miele induction cooktop and oven, an integrated fridge, semi integrated dishwasher, and an undermount sink and you have an exquisite, functional space.











KITCHEN MORE THAN \$80,000

Forrest

This wonderful 1970's home in Forrest was crying out for a sympathetic makeover. The brief for the kitchen component was to create a functional new heart that seamlessly assimilated with the other remodeled indoor and outdoor spaces. A priority was to respect the integrity of the original architecture. To reflect the quality of the property, top of the line appliances and tapware were carefully selected, and porcelain floor tiles, natural marble stone and coloured joinery applied, to complement the existing refurbished elements. Rare slabs of marble were sourced and hand selected by a specialist Stone Mason. Without doubt the stunning marble is the main feature of the kitchen.

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


SUSTAINABILITY IN HOUSING

It's no secret that sustainable housing is on the rise across Australia, including here in the Nation's Capital. From incorporating energy efficient materials into a new home to retrofitting an existing property with airtight doors and windows, there is a growing number of trends in sustainability.

A home design which is quickly becoming more prevalent in Australia is Passive House design. A Passive House is generally made with special window fittings and a building shell that has highly insulated walls, roof and floor slab. It is designed to keep the home at an ideal temperature and maximise on energy saving.

Robert Hunklinger from Gen 5 Constructions notes the shift in client's requests for Passive Homes, "Passive Houses, like the one we recently built in Turner, are becoming a lot more popular in Australia and even here in Canberra. It's still a very new concept to a lot of builders but I can see it really taking off in the next few years," he said.

The prospect of saving on your energy bills while assisting the environment is certainly ideal for some people. For many, the desire to have a semi self sufficient home which assists in reducing the heating and cooling costs is becoming an increasing priority.
