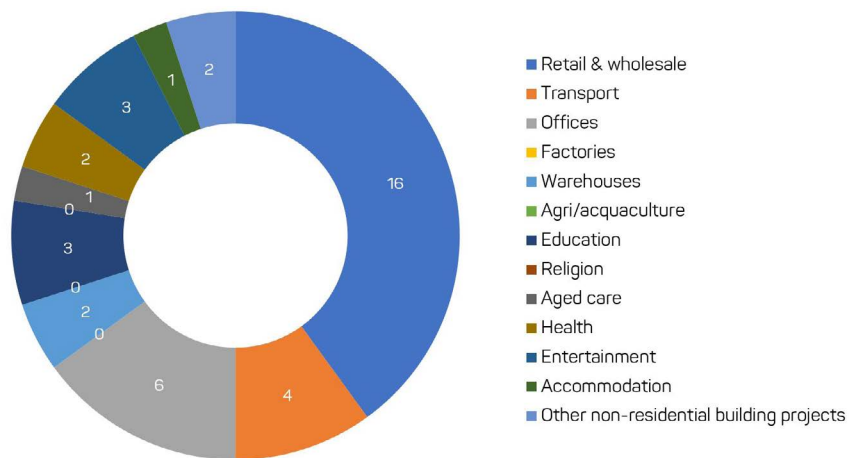
## **AUSTRALIAN CAPITAL TERRITORY**

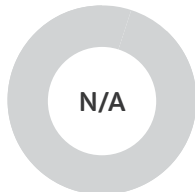

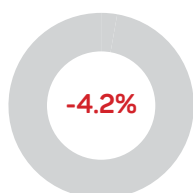

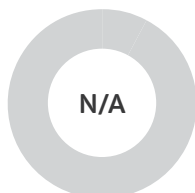

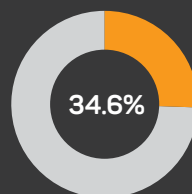

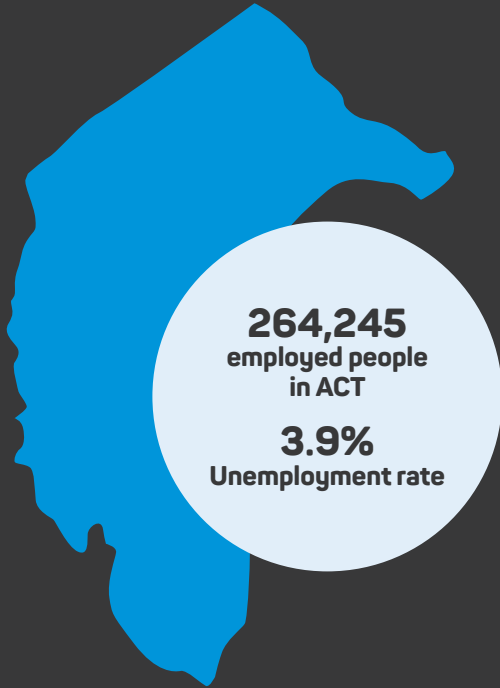
