ACT businesses win big at national building awards

ACT businesses have made a remarkable impact on the national construction stage overnight. Master Builders ACT members won a total of nine national awards at the prestigious Master Builders Australia National Excellence in Building and Construction Awards announced last night, Friday 28 November, in Adelaide.

Following the Master Builders ACT and Asset Construction Hire Awards held in September, local winners advanced as finalists in 34 categories at the national awards.

Projex Building Group won the National Assisted/Adaptable Living Award for their Whitlam project, along with the National Commercial/Industrial Construction Award for projects valued between \$10 to \$20 million for the Gugan Gulwan building, alongside CK Architecture.

Kane Constructions was awarded both the National Commercial/Industrial Construction Award for projects valued between \$50 to \$100 million, as well as the National Commercial Historical Restoration/Renovation Award, for their exceptional work on the Australian War Memorial Southern Entrance. This project had earlier earned them the prestigious Project of the Year title at the ACT awards.

RAM Constructions received the National Commercial/Industrial Construction Award for projects under \$5 million with their innovative Denman Village Park Amenities Building, while Fore Group's restoration of the historic West Block building in the Parliamentary Triangle was awarded the National Fitout Award for projects exceeding \$10 million.

The National Display Home award categories featured impressive wins from Prof Homes, who took home the award for National Display Home over \$800,000 with their Denman Prospect display, while Sunny Homes ACT/NSW clinched the award for Display Home valued \$400,000 to \$600,000 for their Googong display.

Finally, Multiplex Constructions was awarded the National Health Facility Award for their Canberra Hospital Expansion Project.

Anna Neelagama, CEO of Master Builders ACT, said “To have this many finalists at a national level is a huge achievement in itself. It is a testament to the incredible quality of building and construction from our members in the ACT. This underscores our commitment to supporting members to build a quality industry for our members and region. Congratulations to all winners.”

The Master Builders Australia National Excellence in Building and Construction Awards celebrate the highest standards in the construction industry, highlighting the skill and innovation of builders across the nation, while the CCF National Earth Awards recognise excellence in national civil construction.
